BREAKOUT SESSION:

Duration: 50 minutes

Plus 10 minutes of audience Q&A

Presenter facilitates networking with a smaller group (less than 50 participants) on a particular topic.

WORKSHOP:

Duration: 90 minutes

Presenter leads an in-depth discussion and collaborative problem-solving on a particular topic.
